Education and Experience

Graduation from an accredited four year college or university with a bachelor of science degree in nursing. In addition, four years of progressively responsible experience as a public health nurse after receipt of a California public health nurse certificate -- two years of the required experience must be as a supervisor in a public health agency.

Possession of a Master's Degree in Nursing or Public Health may substitute for one year of the required non-supervisory experience.

A valid **CALIFORNIA** Public Health Nurse Certificate is required at the time of application; a valid **CALIFORNIA** license as a Registered Nurse is required at the time of application and must be maintained throughout employment. A license in a probationary status is a disqualification.
