EDUCATION TRAILER BILL – AB 167

Apportionment for Quarantine ADA

• The bill includes amendments clarifying that local educational agencies can earn apportionment for students participating in independent study because of COVID-19-related quarantine, beginning day one of the quarantine. The bill also clarifies that local educational agencies may not file a J-13a for COVID-19 quarantine-related material decreases in ADA or school closures.
