HUMAN SERVICES TRAILER BILL SUMMARY – AB 120

Please note, the below summary only highlights items anticipated to be of interest to local health departments.

IHSS Collective Bargaining Withholding

- Increases the amount of the 1991 Realignment funding withholding from 7 percent one-time to 10 percent ongoing of the county's prior fiscal year IHSS MOE requirement, beginning October 1, 2023, in any counties without an IHSS collective bargaining agreement.
- Specifies that for the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the county enters into a collective bargaining agreement, the county's allocation shall be increased by the amount of the reduction made in the prior fiscal year.
- Specifies that any amount withheld from counties shall be deposited into the General Growth Subaccount of the Sales Tax Growth Account of the Local Revenue Fund for distribution to Health, Mental Health, and Child Poverty and Family Supplemental Support Subaccount. Amounts distributed from the General Growth Subaccount into other accounts shall be considered one-time deposits and not be included in realignment bases for the Health, Mental Health, or Child Poverty and Family Supplemental Support subaccounts in subsequent years.
