RE: Future of Public Health Workforce and Infrastructure Investment – SUPPORT BUDGET ACT AGREEMENT

Dear Senator Wiener and Assembly Member Gabriel,

The undersigned organizations, representing the California Can't Wait Coalition, respectfully urge your support of the final budget act agreement which maintains \$276.1 million ongoing General Fund for state and local public health workforce and infrastructure, including \$184.1 million for local health departments. Our coalition acknowledges the difficult decisions prompted by the state's challenging budget climate, and we commend the Legislature's leadership in working to maintain these critical resources to protect and promote the health of our California communities.

With the Future of Public Health funds, local health departments throughout the state have hired more than 1,100 public health professionals, including public health nurses, disease investigators, epidemiologists, microbiologists, health equity professionals, and other skilled public health professionals. Staff positions supported by this funding have been deployed to respond to communicable disease outbreaks among unhoused and other vulnerable populations, strengthened partnerships and engagement with local stakeholders and community-based organizations, and enhanced preparedness for public health emergencies, among other critical activities.

We must acknowledge the lessons learned from the COVID-19 pandemic, especially that state and local health departments are instrumental in protecting lives, ensuring health equity, and avoiding excess social and economic disruption. Our local health departments are the first line of defense against all public health threats and rely on a highly skilled and specialized workforce supported by this funding.

We are grateful to the Legislature and Administration for maintaining a level of commitment to rebuild our state and local public health workforce and infrastructure. It is for these reasons our coalition respectfully urges your support of the final budget act agreement.
