RE: Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) and Health Care Program for Children in Foster Care (HCPCFC) – SUPPORT BUDGET ACT AGREEMENT

Dear Senator Wiener and Assembly Member Gabriel,

The undersigned organizations, representing California's local health departments, social services agencies, their workforce, and impacted children and families, write to express our support for the provisions included in the final budget act agreement related to the creation of the standalone Health Care Program for Children in Foster Care (HCPCFC) upon the sunset of the Child Health & Disability Prevention (CHDP) Program. We respectfully request your support on the final budget act agreement.

Specifically, language included in the final agreement provides a process for counties to seek flexibility in program staffing and administration to implement and operationalize standalone HCPCFC and the new California Children's Services (CCS) Compliance Monitoring and Oversight Initiative. Counties must obtain approval from their local governing boards and Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to deviate from established program methodologies, and counties exercising this flexibility must report to DHCS the utilization of funds in staffing these programs during this time of transition.

Our coalition has appreciated the collaborative engagement with the Senate, Assembly, and Administration throughout the budget process to ensure a smooth transition of these programs serving vulnerable children and youth statewide while preserving local health department staff. We look forward to continuing to engage with the Legislature and Administration on implementation and administration of these important programs.

Our organizations respectfully request your support of the final budget act agreement provisions related to the CHDP sunset and creation of the standalone HCPCFC. Thank you for your time and attention to this important matter.
